



## CHECKLIST - journalists (not freelances)

---

You are requested to hand in the following documents:

- Completed and signed application form
  - 2 recent passport sized photographs
  - Passport with a validity exceeding three months after your scheduled return<sup>1</sup>
  - Photocopy of information page of current passport
  - Interior passport and its photocopy
  - Travel insurance covering Schengen countries with a minimum coverage of 30 000 Euro for at least urgent medical treatment, emergency admission to hospital and repatriation

- An original certificate or other document issued by the National Union of Journalists of Ukraine proving that the person concerned is a qualified journalist and a document issued by his/her employer stating that the purpose of the journey is to carry out journalistic work
  - For applicants with a different nationality than Ukrainian or Moldovan: residence permit for the Ukraine
  - Proof of financial means<sup>2</sup>

Other evidence

The foregoing is not an exhaustive list. Each applicant may be asked to provide additional proof if necessary.

<sup>1</sup> In case somebody holds 2 or more passports, all have to be presented.

<sup>2</sup> Solvency, €34 per person per day which proven by either a recent bank statement (not older than 14 banking days) or photocopied proof of purchase of travellers' cheques.
