



CHECKLIST - visiting military and civil burial grounds

You are requested to hand in the following documents:

- Completed and signed application form
 - 2 recent passport sized photographs
 - Passport with a validity exceeding three months after your scheduled return¹
 - Photocopy of information page of current passport
 - Interior passport and its photocopy
 - Travel insurance covering Schengen countries with a minimum coverage of 30 000 Euro for at least urgent medical treatment, emergency admission to hospital and repatriation

- Original official document confirming the existence and preservation of the grave
 - Document confirming the family or other relationship between the applicant and the buried (birth or/and marriage certificate)
 - Return flight/bus reservation, or, if you travel with car, photocopy of green card, driving license and technical passport of the car
 - For applicants with a different nationality than Ukrainian or Moldovan: residence permit for the Ukraine
 - Proof of employment if applicable²
 - For minors that are not accompanied by both parents: notarised parental consent
 - Proof of financial means³

We advise you to submit

- a confirmed hotel reservation for the whole period of intended stay

Other evidence

The foregoing is not an exhaustive list. Each applicant may be asked to provide additional proof if necessary.

¹ In case somebody holds 2 or more passports, all have to be presented.

² A recent employer's statement stating the reason and duration of absence, private businessmen should submit a photocopy of the registration of the company instead. If an applicant is unemployed and not registered as a private entrepreneur, this should be written clearly on the application form.

³ Solvency, €34 per person per day which proven by either a recent bank statement (not older than 14 banking days) or photocopied proof of purchase of travellers' cheques.
