



## CHECKLIST – spouses and partners of Dutch who live together in Ukraine

---

You are requested to hand in the following documents:

- Completed and signed application form
  - 2 recent passport sized photographs
  - Passport with a validity exceeding three months after your scheduled return<sup>1</sup>
  - Photocopy of information page of current passport
  - Interior passport and its photocopy
  - Travel insurance covering Schengen countries with a minimum coverage of 30 000 Euro for at least urgent medical treatment, emergency admission to hospital and repatriation

- Proof of employment/study<sup>2</sup>
  - Proof of financial means<sup>3</sup>
  - For minors that are not accompanied by both parents: notarised parental consent
  - For applicants with a different nationality than Ukrainian or Moldovan: residence permit for the Ukraine
  - Copy of the first page of referent's passport and residence permit for Ukraine
  - If applicant and Dutch partner are married, copy of marriage certificate
  - A signed Model M47 (guarantee statement) by the referent (see downloads)

Other evidence

The foregoing is not an exhaustive list. Each applicant may be asked to provide additional proof if necessary.

<sup>1</sup> In case somebody holds 2 or more passports, all have to be presented.

<sup>2</sup> Students must submit a recent statement or certificate from the University with permission of absence and a copy of student's ID, employees should submit a recent employer's statement with permission of absence, private businessmen should submit a photocopy of the registration of the company.

<sup>3</sup> Solvency, €34 per person per day which proven by either a recent bank statement (not older than 14 banking days) or photocopied proof of purchase of travellers' cheques.
